It was in 2005 that I met Renée Robinson, she was working with Andre who was in the middle of retrieving his designs from the Princess Diana estate, and he was surrounded by important people when I went to visit for critique of my current illustrations for him. Her persona is highly professional. She is captivating, dynamic and gently quite. I was taken by her being so well-spoken and I liked her a lot. In a shot time Renée became the manager for Andre Van Pier.



His studio became far more organized. He became even more inspired if that was possible. Renée opened up international venues he had not thought of (she traveled to Dubai and Abu Dhabi), which was were the Andre Van Pier Gold and Platinum collection was being considered for the future Guggenheim in Abu Dhabi. Andre and Renee worked tirelessly with backers and image illustrators putting the concepts and prototypes into a reality presentation mode.

Renée and I became good friend as we saw each other about two times a week and spoke on the phone frequently. I found Renée to be very hard-working, she has the skills to get along with many creative personality types which this job showcased. She has patience and can see the larger picture of the future. She is a realist as she noted early on that the economy was changing and she became worried about Andre and started him working on the weekends as a top stylist. Renée during this period supported herself through teaching and managing other dance companies and artists. She is a master multi-tasker.

Andre died unexpectedly. However, before his death, Renée went to the hospital several times bringing Andre things and preparing for his return home. We were shocked when we heard of his passing. Yet through it all, she remained a professional.

Andre mentioned to me that he adored the problem solving aspects of their work together and Renée loved the dynamic environment of the contacts and confluence of creativity and production. She did a spectacular job for Andre, she would be there for him and she was his most trusted professional facilitator.

I am always further impressed continuously with Renée and her life wisdom. I could not more highly recommend her on every level morally, professionally and as a friend. She is considerate, careful, and generous and has a global sense of communication, politics and humanity. You could do no better in using Renée for your creative and artistic endeavors!
